

Voter Awareness Forum (VAF)

- WHAT: VAF is informal forum for generating discussions and awareness around the electoral process, on the how, what and where of Registration & Voting through activities. VAFs in Government Departments, Non-government Organizations as well as in Corporates shall spread voter awareness and facilitate voter education.
- MEMBERS: All employees, including contractual employees, shall be members of VAF.
- STRUCTURE: Head of each organization/ office shall be the chair of the VAF. Chair shall appoint one person as the Nodal officer. Preference shall be given to an officer who has experience

NODAL OFFICER: S/he will act as the convener of the VAF and will coordinate with the Chief Electoral Officer or District Election Officer for VAF resources.

 Nodal Officers of Ministry of Gol shall coordinate with the office of Election Commission of India.


