# Minutes of the 194<sup>th</sup> SLBC and Special SLBC meeting on Financial Inclusion held on July 10, 2025

194<sup>th</sup> State Level Banker's Committee meeting and Special SLBC meeting on Financial Inclusion held on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 at Room Number 505-C, Vallabh Bhawan-II, Mantralaya, Bhopal. The meeting was chaired by Shri Anurag Jain, Chief Secretary, Government of Madhya Pradesh. Senior Officials of Madhya Pradesh Government, Regional Director RBI, Director DFS Shri Jitendra Asati, Chief General Manager SBI and Heads of all member banks ensured participation in the meeting held both physically and virtually.

Shri Tarsem Singh Zira, Convener SLBC welcomed the participants and started the presentation with permission of the Chair. Key discussion points and action emanated from meeting is outlined here under-

#### 1. Confirmation of Last Meeting Minutes

The minutes of 192<sup>nd</sup> and 193<sup>rd</sup> SLBC meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2025 was circulated among members and also uploaded on SLBC website. Since no amendments or suggestions received, minute was unanimously adopted by house.

#### 2. Review of Banking Development in the Madhya Pradesh

Convenor SLBC presented the key banking development of the state for last 3 years. Chief Secretary advised banks for concerted effort to increase per capita loan in the state.

Action: All Banks

#### 3. Review of Annual Credit Plan Achievement for FY 2024-25

Chair expressed displeasure over non achievement of segment wise priority sector target and advised low performing banks (i.e. MPGB, IDBI Bank, Punjab & Sind Bank) to ensure achievement during FY 2025-26. SLBC was advised to monitor the Banks performance regularly.

Action: SLBC & All Banks



#### 4. Credit Deposit Ratio (CD Ratio)

While reviewing the Credit Deposit Ratio of state, it was opined by Agriculture Production Commissioner, if major banks of state will improve their Credit Deposit Ratio, state performance will significantly improve.

Action: Major Banks of the State

For low CD Ratio districts, joint effort of major banks of District and State administration is felt. Area wise action plan for improvement of CD ratio has been urged under guidance of Additional Chief Secretary, Finance Department.

Action: Institutional Finance, Major Banks of the District

To improve Credit off take in Singrauli, Commissioner Institutional Finance will take the lead.

Action: Commissioner, Institutional Finance

#### 5. Three months' saturation Camps on Financial Inclusion

It has been noticed that due to lack of awareness, claim ratio in the state is very low as compared to gross enrollment under the Social Security Schemes i.e. PM Suraksha Bima Yojana and PM Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana. State administration in consultation with banks, should exercise for lodgment of claim in all death cases from 2021 onwards if deceased were insured under the schemes.

Action: DIF & All Banks

Chair directed to extend co-operation and involvement of State Administration at ground level to make the three months' saturation campaign successful. Open account of remaining adults.

Action: DIF & All Banks

#### 6. Opening of Bank Branches in 56 Locations identified by DFS.

Chief Secretary instructed to construct new government premises at remaining 11 locations within 6 months if premises are unavailable and hand over to respective banks for branch opening. Forum also not consented for approval of branches opened at alternative locations i.e. Pipaljhopa, Sanghvi, ChachariyaPani, Rajanialoking to distance more than 5 km from given location Palaskhurd, Panwada, Sirwel and Gadaiga on respective lt.

Action: DIF & respective banks

#### 7. Opening of Bank Branches in Block Centres

Present progress made by the banks reviewed and Chair advised banks to come forward for opening branches in these blocks.

Action: All Public Sector Banks

#### 8. Progress under Government Sponsored Schemes

During review of National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), it was noted that per SHG disbursement in the state is only Rs. 2.26 lakh. Convenor SLBC targeted to achieve this amount to Rs.3.00 lakh during FY 2025-26.

Action: MPSRLM & All Banks

Chief Secretary expressed concern over non-disbursal of 19,000 PM SVANidhi sanctioned cases since January 2025, and instructed all banks to ensure disbursement within 15 days and SLBC to review the progress within next 7 days.

Action: UADD & All Banks

Pendency in claim lodgment for interest subsidy in sanctioned PM SVANidhi cases was also observed, and for which Chair directed all banks to complete this exercise at the earliest. Chair advised DIF to share detail of relevant banks charging higher rate of interest with RBI and RBImay examine the matter to understand any issue of charging excessive interest rate by these banks.

Action: UADD, DIF, RBI & All Banks

During performance review of PMFME Scheme, ACS Horticulture requested banks for convergence of PMFME applications under Agri Infra Fund, enabling applicants to get additional benefit of 3 % interest subsidy and CGTSME fee reimbursement.

Action: All Banks

Agriculture Production Commissioner requested banks for Geo tagging of sanctioned cases under Agri Infra Fund.

Action: All Bank

#### 9. SVAMITVA Scheme

Chief General Manager, State Bank of India flagged legal implication regarding right of mortgage creation under the scheme. Chief Secretary directed ACS, Finance to convene one meeting with banks and apprise the legality under SVAMITVA Scheme. Also, IDFC First Bank was advised to share its procedure to sanction the loan under the scheme.

#### 11. Non-Performing Assets

SLBC Convenor highlighted the high level of NPA under Agriculture, Transfer of Agriculture Lands through sell despite charged to banks and delay in execution of Section 14 application under SARFAESI at District/tehsil Level. Chief Secretary advised to explore possibility for addition of one paragraph in registry/sell deed wherein liability may pass on to the purchaser. Regarding execution of section 14 application, under SARFAESI he ensured to sensitize in next Collector meeting and to issue necessary instructions.

Action: Institutional Finance

Meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the Chair.
